

WATCHUNG RECREATION
COORDINATOR'S REPORT

March 11, 2014

1. Watchung Recreation received a total of \$1335.00 from Green Brook Township for their participation in the Camelback Mountain ski trip held on February 9th. The Borough collected a total amount of \$2374.00 for all tickets and paid a total amount of \$2309.00 leaving a cost of \$65.00 for the total expense of the trip.
2. Mike Onuska had been appointed as a second alternate member to the Recreation Commission by the Mayor and Council at the February 19th meeting.
3. Tickets to the Yankee vs. Mets game for May 12, 2014 have been ordered and will be available for purchase on the Borough's website as soon as they have been received. Ticket prices will be available for \$60.00 which will include the bus transport to and from Yankee Stadium. The Borough was able to purchase the tickets for \$43.25 and secure the bus for \$933.00 with the parking fee. The \$60.00 per person fee will cover the entire cost of the tickets including the bus. If we sell all 46 purchased tickets as well as 3 of the 4 free tickets we will have a total of \$17.50 left over. One of the free tickets will go to B. Jacques who will be the contact person on the day of the trip.
4. On Feb. 20th two representatives from the Hurley Agency, the Borough's insurance company, came in to discuss the requirements for JIF (The Joint Insurance Fund) for all programs, events and Borough trips. It was brought to our attention as to what the Borough should carry extra insurance for, what would require a contract and what would require a Hold Harmless agreement. Also mentioned at the meeting was that the Hurley Agency would like to make a donation to the Community Picnic event and supply us with a banner that we could use at the event. Since the meeting the Field Permit application has been revised to include the newly formatted Hold Harmless Agreement with the changes that were necessary according to the Hurley Agency.
