A. Ellis mentioned there might be other options that would suit the needs of the students better. Also mentioned was to ask L. McCloud the school psychologist or Debbie Rosenberg from the Bayberry Child Study Team their thoughts on the programs being offered, Girls on the Run and Girls on track.

Ellis mentioned including someone from the Board of Education as a member of the Youth Service Commission as well as including Youth members in 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade or in the high school.

**Cindy Britt** – C. Britt discussed several programs that are being offered in other towns that are being run with the County Annual Grant funds like the Lunch Time Mentoring program, the Boys Council and the Girls Circle. She also mentioned that programs could be run in conjunction or partnered with the Recreation Commission or the PTO or a town business. C. Britt also mentioned that a curriculum of any program can be shared with another town.
