Meeting Called to Order: By M. Nunn at 4:30 pm

Reports: Watchung Recreation plans to run the Summer Camp program at Brook Hill Swim and Tennis Club again this summer. Registration is now open to Watchung residents at a discounted rate of \$225.00 per child/per week until April 30th after which prices increase to \$250. pp/per week. Warren, Green Brook and Long Hill Township residents will be welcome to register after April 30th for \$250.00 pp/ per child.

WHRHS is now collecting donations towards Project Graduation. As not all members were in favor of the program, the Commission did not vote in favor of a donation to the program.

M. Alberto has been appointed as a member of the Municipal Alliance as of March 15th along with being appointed as a councilwomen for the Borough of Watchung on Feb. 15, 2018.

New Procedure to the grant payment process; After a grant has been awarded the County Board of Chosen Freeholders will provide a Resolution number, purchase order number, amount of the grant and program title[s] to the Borough. The town will then submit this in information in an invoice to the Office of Youth Services in order to receive funding.

New Business: As the Youth Services Commission can partner with organizations such as the Municipal Alliance and the Recreation Commission and that we now have three members that are each in two of those organizations, the Commission discussed how these organizations can work together.

M. Alberto made a motion to donate \$200.00 to the Community Picnic event run by the Recreation Commission, M. Nunn second the motion. All were in favor.

Treasurer report: The balance in the donation account is \$267.15. A total of \$5,512.13 remains in the grant account which includes the leftover funds from previous years along with the 2017/18 \$5000.00 grant, although salaries have not yet been invoiced for the GOT program which ran in the fall of 2017.
