**New Business:** The Commission discussed some 2014/15 Competitive Grant options. C. Britt reported that the grant is specific to the at risk population and talked about the idea of doing another Police Academy program or possibly an Adventure Camp. She mentioned how these programs help students build social skills, help with poor self-esteem, stress and anger management. M. Nunn mentioned that the program would be more cost effective if they didn't have to supply lunch. J. Malchow suggested asking the PTO if they could donate lunch for the program. M. Nunn suggesting possibly running a five day Police Academic program in the a.m. and a Jr. Academy program in the afternoon.

**Cindy Britt** – County Report; C. Britt mentioned that there is a delay in the passing of the budget and she expects it to be passed at the next county meeting in May. Until then she would not know what is available if anything as far as a Competitive grant amount.

**Input/Discussions:** C. Britt mentioned that the quarterly report is due to the county by April 5, 2014. M. Nunn mentioned that some amounts might not have been submitted to the Borough for payment like the purchases made for the Anti-Bullying bracelets and banner.
