


Important Notice for Cat Owners!

CAT LICENSES ARE DUE IN MAY!



2004 cat licenses, due during the month of May, may be purchased at the Borough Clerk's office or through the mail. The State Board of Health requires a certificate of vaccination against rabies which is valid through the current licensing year. A license cannot be issued without proof of a current vaccination. Please mail proof or bring in proof of vaccination with your license application. All cats who are seven months old or more must be licensed.

If you have more than one cat to register, please provide requested information for each cat. You may use a separate sheet of paper or pick up additional registration forms at Borough Hall. Proof of vaccination must be submitted with this form for each animal registered.
