WHEREAS, local leaders are looking for ways to promote active living, healthy eating, and overall wellness in their communities; and


WHEREAS, the Mayors Wellness Campaign seeks to work with all members of the Borough to shape healthier lifestyles for men, women and children wour community; and



WHEREAS, a proposal was obtained from ACCSES NJ under State Contract T-1480 77110 for these services; and


WHEREAS, the proposal has been reviewed and determined to be the best option for the Borough; and


