#### **MAYOR'S FINAL ADDRESS**

Mayor Balla stated the following:

"I would like to share some comments as my term serving the residents of Watchung as your Mayor comes to a close. I was truly humbled by the privilege to have been elected to serve as Mayor of Watchung. As elected public servants we have an awesome privilege and responsibility to serve all residents of Watchung and I thank all of the resident for their trust, confidence and encouragement in leading the Borough over the past 4 years.

I thank all of my Council colleagues who have worked with me to provide the best services to all in our community I thank all of our employees who have worked tireless with me to provide services to our residents and make Watchung the best community to live, work and raise our families. I thank all of the many volunteers who have given of their time, talents and treasures to bring community unity, happiness, safety and beautification within in Watchung. I have always said our greatest resource in our community is our residents, young and old with diverse experiences, expertise and

abilities. We have the intelligence, honesty, integrity and experience to ensure that Watchung is a desirable community to live, work, educate and raise families and strengthen the friendships and bonds between us.

There have been many accomplishments over the past 4 years and there have been challenges as well. We have drastically improved the communications and transparency over the period with all agendas and draft materials published in advance of the meetings. We instituted video and zoom of all meetings to allow for everyone, anywhere to participate live in our meetings.

We made vast improvements and repairs to our Borough properties and roads. We ran fiscally responsible operations which produced the largest surplus in funds for future use. I was able to successfully negotiate a favorable financial agreement with the developer of the Bonnie Burn Redevelopment project which will benefit the Borough over the next 30 years. We improved public safety by bringing our police department to full complement and lowering the speed limits. We fostered community engagement with town hall meetings and special committees for the annual budget; road safety; cannabis; diversity inclusion and equity; the library; uses for our parks and property development.

Some of the challenges were ensuring the safety of our resident and employees and volunteers during the worldwide Covid 19 pandemic and the massive property devastation caused by Hurricane Ida. Both of these challenges brought about some memorable moments. During the State of Emergency for Covid we established a hotline for residents in need to assist the elderly or compromised residents and I would go to their homes to get their list of groceries and other items needed and do their shopping knowing, they didn't need to take a risk, and seeing the joy when I brought the items back to their homes left an indelible mark on me. During the flooding of Hurricane Ida I went to the police station to work with the Police Chief

and officers and emergency personnel. As they rescued stranded motorist, we provided a safe rescue area in our court house where we assisted individuals and worked to get each of them safely home through the entire night. Bringing calm and security to individuals during a very traumatic event emphasized what is truly important in life.

Serving as Mayor of Watchung I would pray each day that God would grant me the wisdom to know right from wrong and to do what is right and pleasing to both God and my neighbors. If we are blessed with all of the riches of the world but can't love our neighbor, we are nothing. If we have all of the knowledge of the world but can't love our neighbor, we have nothing. My pray for the future is that each of us would love our neighbors as ourselves. Use each day to bring a smile and joy to someone. I thank my loving wife Karen and my three children, Jonah, Noah and Hannah for all of their love, support and encouragement.

What has carried me through all of life's journey and trials has been my faith in my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit who refreshes me each day. As a youngster I recognized that you come into this world with nothing and when you go home to heaven you don't bring anything with you, so while we are here, we should use each moment to
