PUBLIC NOTICE
2014/2015 DEER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

The Borough of Watchung wishes to inform all Borough residents and non-resident Borough property owners that a Borough-controlled deer management program will begin on December 1, 2014 and may continue until February 13, 2015. The program will be conducted under the same format as that previously utilized under the Community Based Deer Management Program.

The deer management program will be conducted as follows:

Controlled hunting via firearm by Warren Blue Ridge Sportsmen, Inc. will take place on three tracts of municipal land, and also on five tracts of privately owned land from December 1, 2014 through February 13, 2015, as permitted by State regulations. Shooting is limited to the eight sites approved and designated in the program and will only be done from elevated tree stands.

A 24 hour telephone hot line will be in operation at the Watchung Borough Municipal Building and will be maintained by the Borough to provide updated information to residents as to which dates the tracts will be utilized. The hot line number is 908-745-2111 Option 1. This information will also be placed on Local Cable Access Channel 15, and posted on the Watchung Borough website: www.watchungnj.gov. Culling will take place on the following tracks Monday through Friday, dusk to dawn. If any new tracks are added or removed this notice will be updated.

WATCHUNG BOROUGH DEER CULLING TRACKS
2014/2015 SEASON

- Site # 1 – 19.8 acres west end of Mountain Boulevard
- Site # 2 – 6.4 acres – between Route 22 and Johnston Drive – east end
- Site # 3 – 9.56 acres on Sequoia Drive
- Site # 4 – 1.4 acres east on Mountain Boulevard
- Site # 5 – 1.5 acres on northwest side of High Tor Drive
- Site # 6 – 40 acres on Bonnie Burn Road
- Site # 7 – 1.5 acres on Elsinore Drive
- Site # 8 - 3 acres on Acorn Drive
