- Opioids, primarily prescription pain relievers and heroin, are the main drugs associated with overdose deaths. In 2014, opioids were involved in 28,647 deaths, or 61% of all drug overdose deaths.
- According to the *2015 National Survey on Drug Use and Health*, 27% of people ages 18+ and 20% of 12-20 year olds reported binge drinking during the last month.
