Mayor Balla opened up stating that this is the first of the department workshop review as the Governing Body prepares for the upcoming fiscal challenges. This workshop is meant to allow Council Member the opportunity to understand the inner workings of all the various departments.

Fire Chief Albert DeSandolo and Captain Tom Carlucci were present to provide input and answer various questions by the Governing Body regarding the Fire Department's budget. The Fire Chief also spoke on their future budget requests and the replacements that the Department is looking to replace.

The Governing Body made several inquiries on the apparatus, the PPE, replacement of fire gear, and the timing of future purchases and agreements with surrounding municipalities. A detailed breakdown of the department's fleet, vehicle assignments and the departments stipend program was discussed.
