Onuska made a motion to recommend running a "Sunday Family Fun Day" holding a bowling event utilizing some of the remaining Recreation budget and charging \$10.00 per person to participate and cover a portion of the costs. NEW BUSINESS:

The Commission discussed the recommendations on the Capital Budget. L. Monetti mentioned that a grant was available through the county for Municipal Parks and that the grant application will be on the November 4th Mayor and Council meeting for the approval to submit the application.

Discussing Hurricane Ida and the storm damages to Mobus Field, S. Stiles suggested moving the Mobus ball field to Phillip's Field and utilizing the Mobus ball field area for the playground or tennis courts since it is further away from the stream and lake where it may not be subject to future storms.
