# TRAFFIC & BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE MINUTES MAY 28, 2019 / 1:00 PM

Phyllis Juette opened the meeting at 1:00 pm. Those present were Bob Burns, Gail Tafaro, Terry DeFilippis, Linda Lauerman and Vonnie Mott. Discussion in order as follows:

#### **Best Lake**

Tree stump needs to be ground down.

Railroad Tie Curbing needed along parking lot and more gravel.

Need a few more benches along Sidewalk on Valley Road side of walk.

Continue Sidewalk up to Bride's Bridge-looks better than asphalt driveway.

Bottom of Weeping Beech Tree needs to be cleaned out and mulch put down to make a planting area up to and including the Burnheade Pillar.

Place a sign in front of wooden guard rail denoting Best Lake like the sign at Watchung Lake.

Place a split log fence around parking lot.

Continue sidewalk to library and to crossing on Valley Road next to furniture store.

Watchung Sign at bottom of Hillcrest has been weeded and mulched.

Consider planting flowering cherry, pear or dogwoods and viburnum bushes along sidewalk on Valley Road side.

#### **Watchung Circle**

Area behind 911 memorial needs to be cleaned out and evergreens planted White metal railings are rusted and need to be painted black (Bob Burns will check with County).

New Fencing needed along Watchung Falls.

Flood Lights needed at bottom of DAM facing upward.

### **Plantings Needed**

Hydrangea in front of tax office needs to be replaced.

Replace Knock Out Rose bush on left side of Spratford Park plantings.

Plant a Dwarf Gold Mop Cypress and an Alberta Spruce on either side of Watchung Sign.

Need one more evergreen behind Watchung Sign at Spratford Park.

Need evergreen tree to be replaced at EAST side of Best Lake where light is put under tree in winter time.

This is a Tree of Remembrance from the Garden Club for 911. It was vandalized when on the circle. Bob has the plaque.

Replace two dead trees at Bayberry.

Plant slow growing Alberta Spruce along steps at Fire House. Remove old shrubs.

Plant Stella D'Oro Lillies at each end of medians for color. They come back each year.

Plant alternating Dwarf Barbary Bushes and Dwarf Juniper Bushes along Falls in Borough Hall driveway.

### Maintenance

All new plantings need water over summer .

Fix hoses on Water Barrels.

All new trees need to be water bagged.

All vines need to be cut down.

Put protective fencing around Tree Hydrangea at Bayberry.

## **Town Ordinance**

Enforce the ordinance not to feed wildlife. Problem with vultures on Stirling Road.
