Old Business

- COVID-19
 - Food donations – help needed with reorganization
 - Donations still being received
 - Karen and Maryanne have been working organizing
 - Food banks still reporting new registrations
 - Hat and Coat Drive
 - Mayor & OEM worked with a resident who wanted to run this
 - Coats to be donated to food pantry
 - Only new items accepted due to COVID-19
 - Mayor sent a letter with information about various support services
 - Register Ready
 - Residents can sign up for emergency services needs
 - Accessible by OEM head and police chief
 - Registration will help in emergency response
 - Smart 911
 - Vaccines
 - Healthcare workers are in 1a
 - First responders are in category 1b
 - Somerset County does not know if CERT is included
 - Phase 1b should be late January
 - Talk of using RVCC for phase 1a and 1b.
 - High risk is 1c
 - Infection rates are climbing

- NJ is higher than the spring
 - First responder rates, esp. police and fire, are high

New Business

- Weather alert
 - Current forecast for this area is 18" with 35-40 mph winds
 - Anticipate power outages, which would result in CERT activation
 - Warming center will be opened if there are widespread outages
 - DPW sterilized the exempt hall today

 - Masks must be worn and will be provided
 - N95 for CERT
 - Hospital masks for public
 - Should temps be taken?

 - For now, expect it will not be an issue
