Condition of gazebo on Mountain Blvd was discussed. We were reminded by Mary Ann that Barbara Diem donated the gazebo and we should do repairs to maintain it. All members are in favor of adding lights around the roof, but the cost of an electrical supply is exorbitant.

We agreed on the menu and Catherine will order, pickup and deliver to the men on Thursday, December 8th at 11:30. Other members will help deliver if available. May Planting

Note: All planting areas on the circle have been leveled, cleared of old shrubbery and topsoil added. Christine Ead said a landscape plan will be drawn up and presented to T&B for these areas. Evergreens in planting beds: Phyllis suggested Gold Thread Cypress surrounded by Plum Yew.

Areas to be planted: Planting beds on the circle, Spratford Park, Borough Hall grounds, Flag pole, 911 Memorial, ends of medians. Plant around the base of the tree of lights if the horse nettle and other weeds are not present. Need to order 400/6" pots of vinca (mixed colors) from Gray's. Vinca should be planted 2 pots per foot. Suggestion for planting on the South side of Best Lake: Red Cardinal flowers.

Medians Somerset Street: Phyllis recommended planting one white fountain grass and 2 junipers on each end of medians. Vonnie suggested the junipers might not live due to lack of space and water in that area.
